Best of all, GoodSearch can become your search engine on the top of your web browser bar. They talk you through that on the website.

How do we check copyright issues?

Contact the site or organization for permission...that's one way. Jennifer Grove: Yes - check with the author for copyright info. Permission has to be in writing to be legal! how did you access the picture right click on it and "save as" The images on most sites are low-res images, not good for printing...
