




Many Approaches to Working with Men & Boys

- Potential mentors

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





Organization Moves Toward Primary Prevention Required changing some of our strategies... We can't do it by focusing on the victims and potential victims




















RAVE Outcome Evaluation

- On-line pre-post Survey (RAVE and non-RAVE compare group)→ individual KABBs
- Focus Groups with 6 groups of students and adults → is RAVE impacting the social norms in the school?



2010-11

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RAVE evaluation findings

Indicators of Success:

Focus Groups: All groups identified RAVE as a factor in what sets the norms in the school around TDV (along with: what adults do, policy, other student groups)



- Pre/Post Survey: RAVE group 20% higher across questions at "pre" stage vs. non-RAVE group
- "That's so RAVE-like!" saying emerged on campus
- Member interviews: "like brothers"
