# How **Oppression** Connects to Sexual Violence

The belief that certain people (typically white, able-bodied, heterosexual, cisgender) are superior and should therefore **dominate** society, typically to the **exclusion** or **detriment** of other racial and ethnic groups.

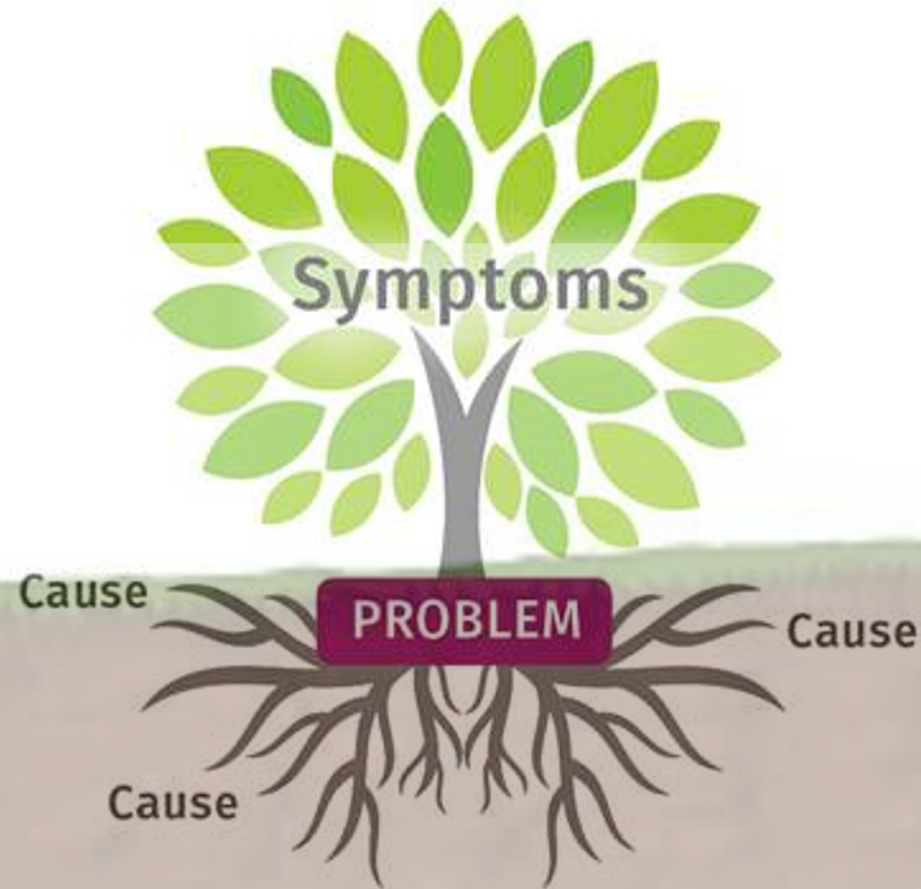

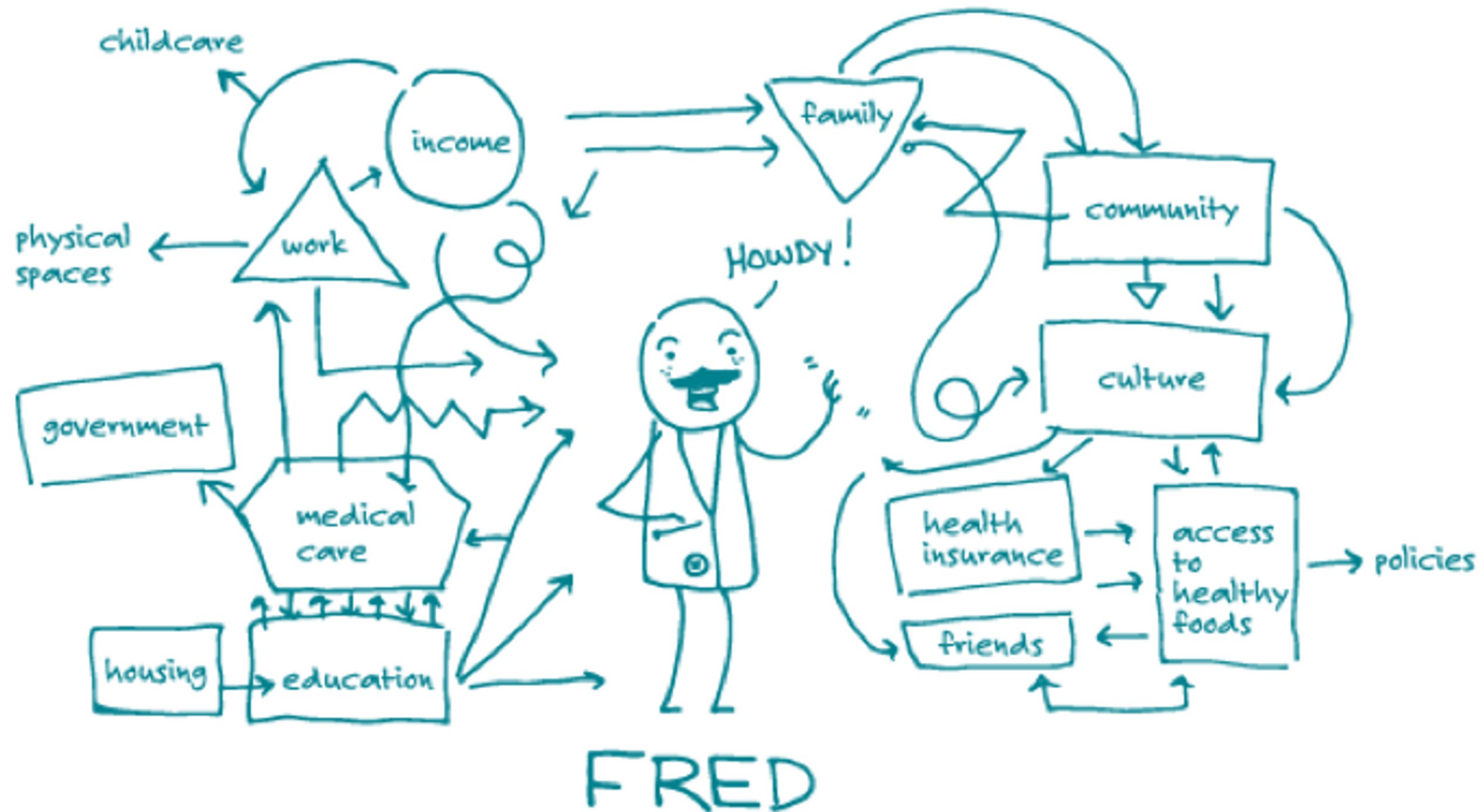

No matter how much Fish 2 tries, it may never reach its full health potential due to its dirty water and cracked bowl.

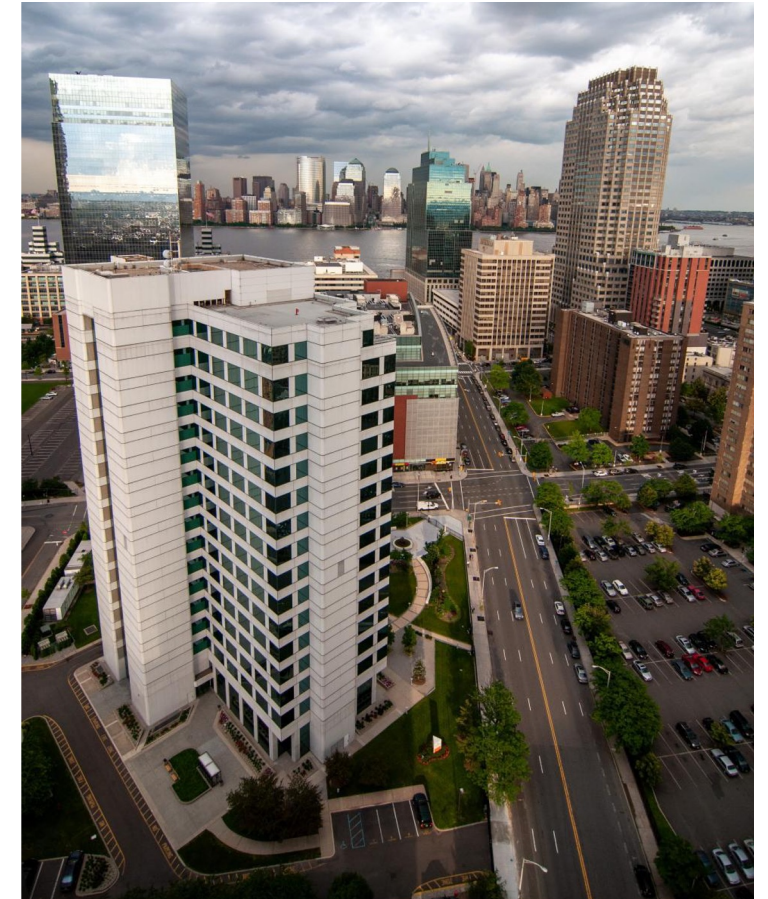

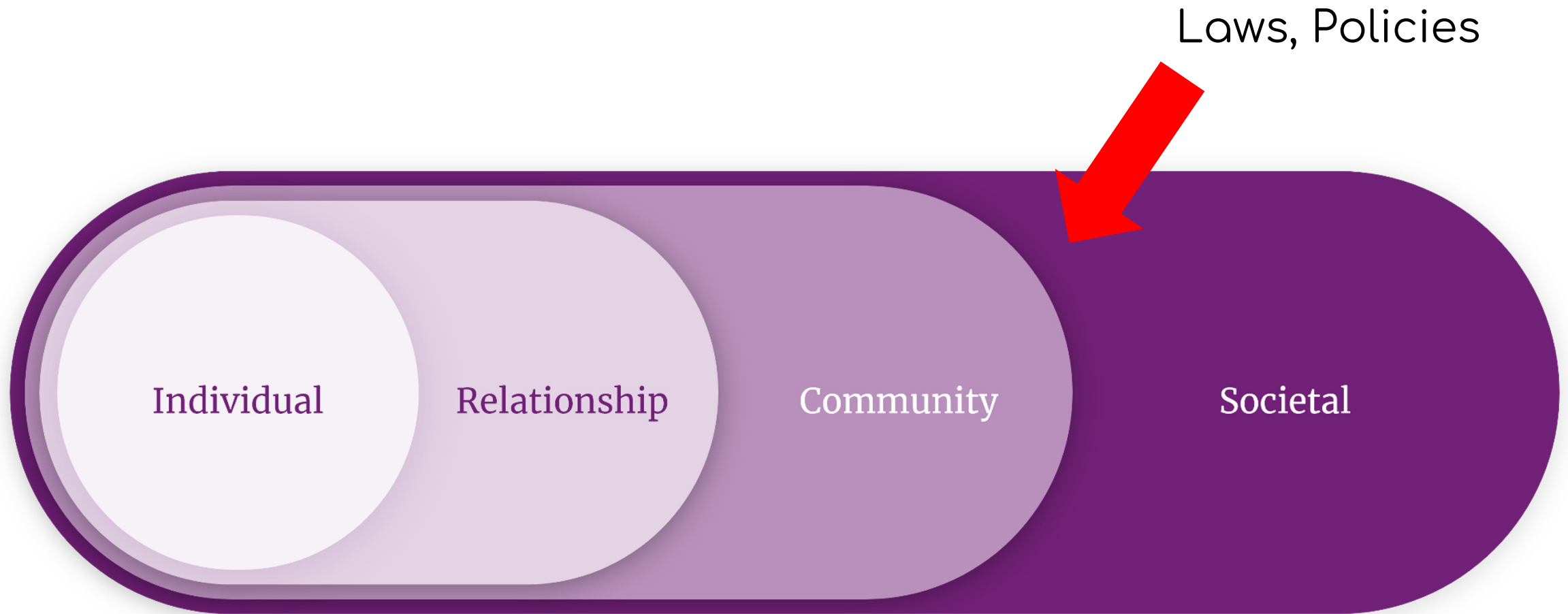

# Addressing the causes of violence

- ▶ The Centers For Disease Control name specific **factors** affect the likelihood that someone perpetrates or experiences violence.
  - ▶ **Risk Factors** increase likelihood of violence
  - ▶ **Protective factors** decrease likelihood of violence
